International Student: Details

Definition: - International students include the following categories:

- Foreign Students: Students holding passports issued by foreign countries including people of Indian origin who have acquired the nationality of foreign countries.
- Non Resident Indians (NRI): Student with NRI status; students who are Indian citizens but have written their qualifying examination (equivalent to the 10+2) from a school or college abroad.
- NRI Sponsored Students: Students are Indian citizens, whose father/mother is an NRI.

Documents Required for Admission

1. VISA (Not required for NRIs)

All the international students will require a student visa endorsed to this Institution for joining full time courses. No other endorsement is acceptable. The visa should be valid for the prescribed duration of the course. A visa is not required for NRI students..

Persons of Indian Origin (PIO), Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) who possess either OCI (Overseas Indian Citizenship) or PIO card do not require Indian Visa. OCI and PIO card gives them freedom to visit India without visa. OCI and PIO cards are multi-purpose life long visa for visiting India. However, those PIOs who do not have PIO or OCI card have to apply for the student visa.

2. NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE

All international students wishing to undertake any research work or join Ph.D or M. Phil. programs will have to obtain prior security clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs and the approval of Department of Secondary & Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development Government of India and this must be on the research visa endorsed to this Institution.

5. EQUIVALENCE CERTIFICATE

In order to avoid any difficulties at a later stage, every student who has studied in a system other than CBSE / ICSE or any State Board in India is advised to obtain an Equivalence Certificate from Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. This is to be produced at the time of admission. Visit their website www.aiu.ac.in for more details.

The following foreign examinations have been recognized by AIU as equivalent to the +2-stage qualification of an Indian Board. Students who have cleared any of these examinations successfully may apply for admission to any of the bachelors programs at Integral University.

- I. 12 years Baccalaureate Certificate of Afghanistan, France, Iraq and Tunisia.
- II. 12 years General Secondary Education Certificate of the Ministry of Education – Bahrain, Egypt, Iran, Jordan, Kuwait, Oman, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates and other Gulf countries.
- III. GCE/IGCSE/GCSE examinations of the approved British Examining Bodies in UK, Singapore, Hong Kong, and Mauritius with passes in 5 subjects at Ordinary Level and 2 subjects at Advanced Level. For admission to professional courses (medical/engineering) Advanced Level passes in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics and English are required besides 5 passes in GCE Ordinary Level.
- IV. High School Diploma from an accredited school in USA.
- V. Intermediate/Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary of the approved Boards in Pakistan, Bangladesh and Nepal.
- VI. 12 years secondary stage qualification of National Examination Board/Council of the Ministry of Education – Kenya, Nigeria, Ethiopia, Sudan, Uganda and Tanzania.
- VII. 12-years Secondary Stage Examination conducted by various Provinces in Australia and Canada.
- VIII. GCE Ordinary and Advanced Level examination of the Department of Examination, Government of Sri Lanka.
- IX. 12-years STPM examination of Malaysia.
- X. 12-years Secondary Stage qualification of Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Socialist Republic of Vietnam and Yemen Arab Republic.
- XI. Abitur of Germany.

XII. 12-year High School Diploma awarded by the accredited American School/International Schools in other countries following American pattern of education.

6: NRI STATUS CERTIFICATE (Required only for NRIs) in respect of father/mother

7: EMPLOYERS CERTIFICATE of parent sponsoring the student (in case of NRI admission)

8: MEDICAL FITNESS CERTIFICATE

9: FRRO/FRO Registration Proof

All foreigners (including foreigners of Indian origin) visiting India on long term (more than 180 days) Student Visa, Medical Visa, Research Visa and Employment Visa are required to get themselves registered with the Foreigners Regional Registration Officer (FRRO)/ Foreigners Registration Officer (FRO) concerned having jurisdiction over the place where the foreigner intends to stay, within 14 days of arrival. However, Pakistan nationals are required to register within 24 hours of their arrival. All Afghan nationals are required to register with the FRRO/FRO concerned within 14 days of arrival except those Afghan nationals who enter India on a visa valid for 30 days or less provided the Afghan national concerned gives his/her local address in India to the Indian Mission/FRRO/FRO. The Afghan nationals who are issued visas with "Exemption from police reporting" are exempt from Police reporting as well as Exit permission provided they leave within the Visa validity period.
